feelings of guilt. A US company has invented a cell phone so that dogs and their owners can communicate when they are away from each other. The PetsCell is a small 3-inch by 5-inch bone shape device that attaches to a dog's collar. It works in the same way as a conventional mobile phone. The owner dials the dog's number and is automatically connected after one ring to the phone on the collar. The dog hears its master's voice transmitted through a speaker built into the collar piece. If the dog barks, the owner hears it through their telephone. The device is expected to be available within the next several months and cost about \$188. For more information Click here
