2. Do You Live With A Nervous Nellie?

Stress is a killer for both humans and animals. Many times we can not change or eliminate the cause of the stress, such as a thunder storm, for example. We can however, help change our pet's behavior by utilizing what is called an Anxiety Wrap.

The Anxiety Wrap was developed by two Tellington Touch Practitioners, Susan Sharpe and Kimberly Ring.

The Anxiety Wrap is a holistic method which can help aid in modifying the pet's behavior in a stressful situation. In fact, in many cases the wrap has been found to be helpful even in training, nail cutting, barking or socialization settings just to name a few.

By basic design, the Anxiety Wrap uses what is termed "Maintained Pressure" which helps calm sensory receptors through the body.

The sensory receptors role is to report feedback to the brain from organs, muscles, joints, connective tissue, eyes, ears and nose. After gathering all this incoming data, the brain then interprets and activates the body into action. In fact, if your pet is prone to such behavior, they may exhibit stress even if there is no danger to them at all. In cases such as these, the pet's sympathetic nervous

system takes over control.

The Anxiety Wrap maintains pressure to calm the pet by causing a decline in sensitivity at the receptor level.
